



# Frank Hodges Jr. Physical Disability Scholarship

Established in 2001, this fund has been made possible through a gift from the estate of Jessie Hodges Benton, in honor of her brother, Frank Hodges, Jr. Frank, who was totally deaf, graduated from the University of Missouri in 1923 with a degree in engineering. The fund has been established to provide scholarships to students with physical disabilities (mobility, vision, hearing, health related).

*The Disability Center will provide recommendations for awards to the MU Student Financial Aid Office, which administers the fund.*

To qualify, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a student at the University of Missouri
- Be currently registered with the Disability Center
- Be receiving academic accommodations
- Have a documented physical, sensory or health related disability
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.0
- Must not be on academic probation
- A current, unofficial transcript should be included with the application.
